

How to help Regions to increase incident (learning) sharing

- But why share incidents?
- It helps to improve the safety performance of all members
- Everybody can make mistakes; but it does not make any sense to repeat mistakes
- The number of near misses and smaller incidents give an indication of the safety behaviour





- Incident Sharing remains a challenge for WCC
- In the past WCC had a database for incidents
 - But data collection stopped in 2011
 - Why???
- Sharing of incidents in WCC GST meetings is very limited
- What can we do to improve???




- How to convince members to share?
- Make them aware of the importance

Sharing your incident might help to avoid similar incidents happening at all other producers

This will increase safety knowledge in all installations and reduces the number of incidents

Reducing the number of incidents also reduces the chance of a big mishap that affects us all







Organised workshop: learning from incidents

Actions we took to improve

• A practical example; Several incidents happened with PP/FRP as construction







Main lessons learned: PP/FRP is a good construction material; but limited lifetime; difficult to inspect and predict remaining lifetime; temperature fluctuations and areas with bends, connections makes the material more vulnerable and use in these conditions is not recommended;

Euro chlor recommendation is changed accordingly



New WCC Manufacturing process publication

- We added the oxygen depleted cathode process to the membrane process
 - This process uses less electricity but requires pure oxygen and doesn't produce Hydrogen
